GLENORA PRESCHOOL INFORMATION SHEET

Glenora Preschool is a parent owned, parent operated cooperative offering classes for children ages 3 and 4 years old. Classes are held in the Glenora Community League located at 10426 – 136 St.

Glenora Preschool is a uniquely diverse and inclusive program for children ages three and four. We provide a safe, nurturing and stimulating environment where children can grow to their full potential through:

- An art based program.
- Quality programming with a focus on each individual child's needs and interests.
- Whole child development wherein each child is nurtured emotionally, socially, physically, creatively, and intellectually.

Because of the teacher/adult to child ratio (2 teachers and 1 parent volunteer for 15 children), the teachers are given an excellent opportunity to really get to know your child and what his or her needs are. The teachers are able to guide your child to an area of play that best suits his or her learning needs. The program is designed to balance physical and intellectual needs with your child's social and emotional needs.

Glenora Preschool is fortunate to be able to utilize a co-teaching format. Our teachers share equally in the preparation of the program and in classroom duties. Our teachers have created a positive, stimulating, warm and caring environment for our children. They are readily available and willing to discuss any questions or concerns.

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The preschool offers 4 classes (with maximum of 15 children per class)

3-year-old morning program runs from 9 – 11:30 am on Tuesday and Thursday	\$135 / month
3/4-blend program runs afternoons from 1 – 3:30 pm on Tuesday and Thursday.	\$135 / month
4-year-old morning program runs from 9 – 11:30 am on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.	\$190 / month
4-year-old afternoon program runs from 1 – 3:30 pm on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.	\$190 / month

Class availability subject to enrolment. Fees Subject to Change. A Non-Refundable registration fee of \$100 and a \$250 post dated pledge cheque must be submitted with registration. Tuition is automatically withdrawn on a monthly basis from September through June and \$50 fundraising tickets are payable in September.

(NOTE: To be eligible for preschool, your child must be 3 by December 31st of the school year and **must be toilet trained** by the first day of school. If your child turns 3 between September and December, fees must be paid to the Preschool in order to hold his or her position in the class and your child may not start preschool until they are 3 years old.)

Being a cooperative preschool, parents volunteer for a special day in their child's class every 6 to 8 weeks. They assist the teachers, bring a snack and spend special time with their child. Parents also choose a job from a job selection list (provided in the registration package). Everyone's contributions help make the preschool the success that it is! Most importantly, we believe that the cooperation between parents and teachers in reinforcing common goals, hopes and caring is an unbeatable combination!
